

## Piecing Instructions

Press as illustrated
RST = Right Sides Together
Use a 1/4" seam allowance throughout

Scrappy Tree Quilt Block
12" Finished Block

Fabrics needed to complete 1 block
(4) $3^{\prime \prime}$ green squares
(6) $21 / 22^{\prime \prime}$ green squares
(6) $3^{\prime \prime}$ red squares
(1) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 4 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ brown rectangle
(10) 3 " background squares
(6) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ background squares
(2) $2^{\prime \prime} \times 41 / 2 \prime$ " background rectangles

1. Mark a diagonal line across the back of a 3 " background square. Place the background square RST with a $3^{\prime \prime}$ green square. Sew $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ away from each side of the marked line. Cut the unit apart on the drawn line.
Press the seams open.
You will have two half square triangles.

Trim each half square triangle to $21 / 2 \prime \times 21 / 2 \prime$. Repeat to make 8 green/background half square triangles (HSTs).

2. Repeat step 1 using $3^{"}$ background squares and $3^{\prime \prime}$ red squares to make a total of 12 red/background HSTs.

4. Sew together the brown rectangle and the 2 background rectangles as shown. Press toward the brown rectangle.

5. Lay out and sew together 3 red HSTs and 1 background square as shown. This unit will measure $41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 4 \frac{1}{2}$ ". Make 2 .

6. Sew together the units made in steps $4 \& 5$ to make the tree bottom. The tree bottom will measure $41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 121 / 2^{\prime \prime}$.
7. Sew the tree top and tree bottom together to complete the Scrappy Tree block. It will measure $121 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 121 / 2^{\prime \prime}$.


Tip: If you are making multiple blocks to use in one project, press all seams open.
