

Scrappy Tree Quilt Block 12" Finished Block

Fabrics needed to complete 1 block

(4) 3" green squares

- (6) 2 ¹/₂" green squares
- (6) 3" red squares
- (1) 1 ½" x 4 ½" brown rectangle
- (10) 3" background squares
- (6) 2 ¹/₂" background squares
- (2) 2" x 4 1/2" background rectangles

Piecing Instructions Press as illustrated RST = Right Sides Together Use a 1/4" seam allowance throughout


1. Mark a diagonal line across the back of a 3" background square. Place the background square RST with a 3" green square. Sew 1/4" away from each side of the marked line. Cut the unit apart on the drawn line. Press the seams open.

You will have two half square triangles.


Trim each half square triangle to 2 ½" x 2 ½". Repeat to make 8 green/background half square triangles (HSTs).



2. Repeat step 1 using 3" background squares and 3" red squares to make a total of 12 red/background HSTs.




 Lay out the tree top as shown.
Sew the pieces together in horizontal rows, pressing adjacent rows in opposite directions.
Sew the rows together pressing the seams in one direction. The tree top unit will measure 8 ½" x 12 ½".



4. Sew together the brown rectangle and the 2 background rectangles as shown. Press toward the brown rectangle.



5. Lay out and sew together 3 red HSTs and 1 background square as shown. This unit will measure 4 1/2" x 4 1/2". Make 2.



- 6. Sew together the units made in steps 4 & 5 to make the tree bottom. The tree bottom will measure 4 ½" x 12 ½".
- 7. Sew the tree top and tree bottom together to complete the Scrappy Tree block. It will measure 12 ½" x 12 ½".
